## The Reality

Even before the war between Israel and Hamas erupted on October 7, Israel faced a significant shortage of rehabilitation beds. The country was already trailing behind other OECD nations in terms of available space for patients in rehabilitation hospitals and centers. While the OECD average for rehabilitation beds is 0.5 per 1,000 people, Israel has only 0.3, which is 60 percent of the average. Currently, the rehabilitation facilities are lacking approximately 500 beds, and at least 100 more rehabilitation doctors are needed over the next five years.



#### The Need

According to the Department of Rehabilitation at the Ministry of Defense, since the Swords of Iron War, there has been an average of 60 new injuries per day, totaling 8,600 wounded, most of whom are reservists. As the war continues, the demand for rehabilitation services and skilled medical staff will grow.



#### **Aleh Zahav Rehabilitation Center**

The new state-of-the-art ALEH Zahav Rehabilitation Center in Ramla is being designed to the highest international standards. It will be a cutting-edge facility, representing the next generation in rehabilitative care, and will attract patients in need of top-quality rehabilitation from across the country.



Located adjacent to the newly built national underground anti-missile blood center by Magen David Adom, this new facility will provide both inpatient and long-term outpatient rehabilitation services to thousands of Israeli citizens and soldiers.

The Center will offer personalized care and specialized treatments to aid in their recovery and return to daily life, implementing cutting-edge rehabilitation techniques and offering the most advanced services available in Israel.



The ALEH Zahav Rehabilitation Center will help meet the urgent needs of thousands of citizens and IDF soldiers who require in and out -patient rehabilitation following a war injury, accident, and stroke or terror attack.

In addition, the Center will also offer unparalleled care for children

and people with severe disabilities in a warm, dignified

environment.

The Israeli government views this project as a crucial component in the ongoing development of rehabilitation services in Israel. Consequently, the Prime Minister's Office and the Ministry of Health are considering a governmental resolution to fund 40% of the building costs.

Israel's Ministry of Defense and all the Health Funds are currently in the process of finalizing a formal agreement to provide services to wounded soldiers and citizens.
